Scholarship Awards

- ❖ Scholarships are available in the amount of \$100 - \$500 per academic term, over 4 academic years (unless extended by special approval).
- ❖ The maximum scholarship in a single academic year is \$1500 for Full time studies. (3 consecutive terms of study – usually Fall, Winter, Summer).
- ❖ The maximum lifetime scholarship per applicant is \$4000.

Eligibility

Scholarships are available for application to:

Members of churches that are affiliated with the Fellowship of Evangelical Baptist Churches in BC and Yukon and who are:

- Children of current Fellowship pastors, missionaries, or personnel employed by a Fellowship of Evangelical Baptist Churches in BC and Yukon ministry or camp for at least three years and who are undertaking full time post secondary studies.

Post Secondary applicants must be enrolled or approved for enrollment in a full course load in the year of application. The program of study must be a recognized full-time undergraduate degree program at a University, Theological College or a recognized full-time program at an accredited Vocational College.

Criteria

Scholarship awards will be based on the academic standing of the applicant during their high school and/or post secondary studies. Indications of future academic excellence will also be considered. Scholarship renewal depends on maintaining a full course load and a minimum 3.0 grade point average in each year of study. Work terms or similar co-op modules do not qualify for scholarship funding.

Scholarship awards, and any exceptions to limits, criteria, or durations are at the discretion of the Trustees of the Scholarship Fund. Trustee decisions regarding the application and approval process are final.

**APPLICATIONS AND RE-APPLICATIONS MUST BE RECEIVED
BY THE ANNUAL DEADLINE OF AUGUST 15 (or the Friday before if the 15th falls on a weekend).**

Application Process

1) **First Time Scholarship Application Procedure:**

Please complete the attached application along with its attachments as outlined in the application form and return to the Awards Officer, Foundation for Fellowship Baptist Ministries, #125, 6165 Highway 17, Delta, BC V4K 5B8 by the closing date of August 15 (or the Friday before if the 15th falls on a weekend) annually.

- ✓ Have you included a copy of your confirmation letter of enrolment? _____
- ✓ Have you provided a copy of the institution's definition of "full course load?"

It is the responsibility of the applicant to ensure that your application is completed and received in full at Baptist Housing Head Office by the August 15 (or the Friday before if the 15th falls on a weekend) deadline. You may contact Head Office Reception at 604-940-1960, ext. 100 to confirm receipt of your package.

2) **Scholarship Re-application Procedure:**

Once the applicant has been approved and has received scholarship funding the first time, the scholar is responsible to re-apply by the annual closing date of August 15 (or the Friday before if the 15th falls on a weekend) each year for the remaining years. The re-application package is to include a:

- ✓ Current **official** copy of the scholar's transcript. An interim unofficial or downloaded transcript will not be accepted.
- ✓ A letter requesting scholarship renewal.
- ✓ A copy of your confirmation letter of enrolment

3) **All Scholarship Applicants**

T4A's and other correspondence may be directed to you during the year. It is your responsibility to ensure that the Awards Officer has your current mailing address and contact information.

4) **Award Notification**

The Awards Officer will respond to scholarship applications within 4 – 6 weeks of the Aug 15 deadline with an acceptance letter and scholarship cheque, or a letter of acknowledgement.

- 2) Two reference letters provided by non family members (i.e. teachers, youth pastor, and employer). These letters may be sent directly to the Trustees, Foundation for Fellowship Baptist Ministries, #125, 6165 Highway 17, Delta, BC V4K 5B8. It is the responsibility of the applicant to ensure the Awards Officer has received reference letters by the closing date of August 15 (or the Friday before if the 15th falls on a weekend).
- 3) Attach a biography report (1,000 words or less) detailing your involvement in social, sports, church, community, and volunteer activities, leadership roles, and educational / career goals.
- 4) Confirmation of enrolment from educational institute, including their stated "full course load" requirements (if applicable).

All application packages must be received in full by August 15
 (or the Friday before if the 15th falls on a weekend) **in order to be considered.**
